APPLICATION: Brush, roller or spray

DRYING TIME: 3H recoat - 12H fully dry

TOOL CLEANING: Water

PREPARATION

Ideal application conditions: Between 12° and 25°C, in dry weather. Ensure the surface is clean, dry and free from varnish or other finishes.

BARE OR OILED WOODS: Lightly sand (240 grit) and remove dust.

STAINED OR VARNISHED WOODS: Sand to the original bare wood. Ensure the wood is dust-free.

BLACKENED WOODS: Wash, leave to dry before application.

APPLICATION

Shake well before use. Apply a generous coat of oil, using a brush or a short pile roller (3 - 5 mm) in order to impregnate the wood. Do not wipe off. Leave it to dry for 4 hours. Apply a second coat of oil without wiping off. The opacity and the colour are visible after the application of the 2nd coat. CAUTION: Oily cloths can self combust. Do not leave impregnated cloths in bundles. Before discarding lay them flat outside to dry to avoid a fire hazard. The finish can vary depending the wood species. Always test products on a spare surface or inconspicuous area.
